As many of you are aware, we have had a few cases of Covid-19 in our building. I wanted to take a minute and explain the process that we follow once a positive case has been discovered. Mrs. Reese, Dr. Lamar Brown (Director of Student Services), and Denise Self (County Head Nurse), are all actively involved in our process. At the school level, the administrators and Nurse Michelle are involved in making sure all procedures are followed. Once we are notified of a positive case (staff or students) we begin contact tracing. We must contract trace back 48 hours. This includes bus, breakfast, lunch, class, and dismissal. Once all the students and/or staff are identified, a direct contact is made with each person/parent. A Remind is sent by the teacher to the classes involved letting them know that a student/or staff has tested positive in their class. A text is followed up by one of the administrators notifying everyone of a positive case at our school. Lastly, an email is sent to all faculty notifying them of the positive case.

Mrs. Smith and I want to wish all our students and their families a very Happy Thanksgiving. I hope you are able to enjoy time with family and friends and most importantly, count your many blessings.
