GOALS FOR STUDENT LEARNING

District Goals:

- To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient (levels 3,4) in grades 3 through 8
- To improve the percentage of students graduating from high school.

School Goals: The percentage of students performing at a level 3 or 4 in English language arts on the GA Milestones test will increase from 48% to 54% this year. In 4th grade our school will focus on:

- Fluency and comprehension

The percentage of students performing at a level 3 or 4 in mathematics on the GA Milestones test will increase from 44% to 50% this year. In 4th grade our school will focus on:

- Math facts- basic multiplication and division.

BES 4th Grade Students

BES students joined staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed. Students thought of the following ideas to make connections between learning at home and school.

Students said:

- **Read my fluency homework Monday through Thursday nights.**
- **Read 10 to 20 minutes after school to help me reach my 9 week AR goal.**
- **Practice math facts on flash cards or online programs.**

The 4th Grade teachers

will work with students and their families to support student success.

Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Keep parents informed about what we are doing in reading/language arts and math on a regular basis.
- Provide appropriate level books to take home weekly to address fluency and comprehension.
- Provide home access to websites such as IXL, Reflex, and Woot Math to build and reinforce math skills.

At Home

BES parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support student success. Here are some things family members believe will show their support of their student's learning:

- Setting aside a quiet place for my child to do homework and make sure they complete it to the best of their ability.
- Check my child's backpack and agenda daily; sign and return weekly communication folders.
- Keeping in contact with my child's teacher through phone, e-mail, online, or face-to-face conversations regarding my child's academic achievements.
